LEAF COLLECTION REGULATIONS

- **ALL leaves and/or yard waste MUST be bagged in BIODEGRADABLE PAPER BAGS or placed in containers not exceeding 35 gallons.**
- **NO PLASTIC BAGS WILL BE ACCEPTED**
- All branches must be cut and tied in bundles no longer than four feet in length.
- Bagged leaves should be placed for pick-up by the curb, not in the street.
- Leaves **CANNOT** be piled in the streets at any time.
- **DON'T** place trash, garbage or other yard rubbish in with leaves.
- **DON'T** place leaves in catch basin.
- Landscaping Contractors and Property Owners are prohibited from blowing any type of yard waste into the street.
- **ALL** Landscaping Contractors **MUST** have a permit by the City of Orange Township.
- **Biodegradable leaf bags are available for Orange Residents only while supplies last at City Hall located on the first floor Security Front Desk.**
