LEAF COLLECTION REGULATIONS

- ALL leaves and/or yard waste MUST be bagged in BIODEGRADABLE PAPER BAGS or placed in containers not exceeding 35 gallons.
- NO PLASTIC BAGS WILL BE ACCEPTED
- All branches must be cut and tied in bundles no longer than four feet in length.
- Bagged leaves should be placed for pick-up by the curb, not in the street.
- Leaves **CANNOT** be piled in the streets at any time.
- **DON'T** place trash, garbage or other yard rubbish in with leaves.
- **DON'T** place leaves in catch basin.
- Landscaping Contractors and Property Owners are prohibited from blowing any type of yard waste into the street.
- <u>ALL</u> Landscaping Contractors <u>MUST</u> have a permit by the City of Orange Township.
- Biodegradable leaf bags are available for Orange Residents only while supplies last at Brook Alley Garage, 24 S. Center Street, Monday - Friday between the hours of 12:30pm – 3:00pm.
