

Used Motor Oil

The dumping of used motor oils is illegal in New Jersey. State law requires all state license reinspection stations, oil retailers, and retail service stations, which have a used oil collection tank existing on their premises, to accept up to ten (10) quarts of used oil per day from any person. State law permits the service station to charge a fee for recycling used oil. There must be nothing but used oil in the container. Antifreeze or any other containment is prohibited from being mixed with used oil.

Leaf Collection

Starts October 15<sup>th</sup> and ends December 15<sup>th</sup>

**Note:** Weather and the amount of leaves to be picked up can affect the City's ability to complete the pick ups by the above date. It is not necessary to call during leaf season for collection. There will be multiple collections during leaf season throughout the City. All leaves and/or yard waste **MUST** be bagged in **BIODEGRADABLE** paper bags only. All branches must be cut and tied in bundles no longer than four feet in length. Leaves **CANNOT** be piled in the streets at any time. **DO NOT** place leaves near any catch basins. Bagged leaves should be placed for pick up by the curb, not in the street. Landscaping Contractors and Property Owners are prohibited from blowing any type of yard waste into the street. Following leaf season, bagged leaves and tied brush can be picked up by appointment only.

Biodegradable leaf bags will be available for Orange Residents while supplies last at Brook Alley Garage, 24 South Center Street, Orange, between the hours of 12:30—3:00 p.m.

Grass, Cut It and Leave It Program

Grass clippings are a major part of Essex County's municipal solid waste stream, and like other highly recyclable materials—such as newspapers, plastics, glass and aluminum , recycling grass clippings can help reduce the amount of waste to landfills.

What can you do to help?

It's real simple. Just leave your grass clippings on the lawn when you mow

Bulky Trash



Bulk Trash consists of mattresses, box springs, wooden furniture, wooded doors, rolled carpet, and other similar items.

**NOTE:** Items such as stumps, logs, any type of yard waste, household, hazardous waste, tires, cardboard boxes, toys, clothes, construction material, electronics, large appliances and any type of metal items are **NOT** classified as bulk trash.

*For general information regarding discarding of clothes, toys, house ware, draperies, etc please call 1(800)775-8387.*

Bulk trash is collected once per week, on the second collection day of the week. For example:

- If your household refuse is collected on Monday & Thursday, then the **bulk** collection will be on that **Thursday**.
- If your household refuse is collected on Tuesday & Friday, then the **bulk** collection will be on that **Friday**.
- If your household refuse is collected on Wednesday & Saturday, then the **bulk** collection will be on that **Saturday**.

NOTE: Main Street Bulk Schedule:

Odd addresses will be collected on Thursday Bulk Collection. Even addresses will be collected on Friday Bulk Collection.

NOTE: Central Avenue Bulk Schedule:

Odd addresses will be collected on Friday Bulk Collection. Even addresses will be collected on Saturday Bulk Collection.

Garbage



Garbage is waste which results from food preparation and other usual household functions, not recyclables, bulky trash, appliances or scrap metal. Garbage is picked up from the curb 2 times a week, not on holidays. If you do not know your garbage pick up days, please call the Public Works Department at (973)266-4030.

**Do not** place garbage for pick up prior to 6:00pm the night before or after 6:00am on your schedule pick up day. Garbage should be in cans or plastic bags for pick up, not in paper bags or boxes.

We do not pick up:

- Construction Debris: The removal and disposal of debris generated by home improvement projects is the sole responsibility of the property owner. We do not pick up broken concrete, asphalt, roofing shingles, dirt, rocks, sheet rock, or other items commonly referred to as construction debris.
- Hazardous Material
- Dirt, stones, concrete, bricks, tree stumps or logs.
- Tires: Contact retail service station for disposal.

Household Hazardous Waste



Household Hazardous waste is a term used to describe household products that contain potentially harmful chemicals such as pesticides, paints, batteries, varnishes, pool chemical and more. A household hazardous collection program has been developed for Essex County resident, available twice per year. **Further information on Hazardous Waste Collection Days will be publicized in the Orange Transcript or Call the Essex County at (973)857-2350**

### CO-MINGLED BOTTLES AND CANS

Co-mingling means mixing in one re-useable container or clear plastic bags:

**NOTE: DARK COLOR BAGS WILL NOT BE ACCEPTED**  
-Aluminum beverage cans –Glass –Plastic Bottles and jars  
-Household tin Cans (pet food cans also) –Plastic soft drink bottles –Milk –Water –Juice Jugs –Laundry detergents –Bleach –Softener bottles

**Clean and drain liquid out of all of the above.**

**For plastic containers rinse, clean, crush, or step on container.**

#### Non Recyclable:

-Window glass and mirrors	-Dishes, drinking glasses
-Light Bulbs	-Spray cans & paint cans
-Aluminum foil pans	-Toys
-Motor oil bottles	-Yogurt cups & food storage tubs
-Bathroom plastics	-Plastic bags

### NEWSPAPERS / CARDBOARD



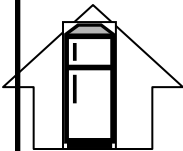
Place in a paper bag or bundle and tie with string or rope  
Bundles should be no higher than 10 inches  
Cardboard should be flattened and tied  
**Do not use stockings, tape or wire for ties**  
**Do not use plastic bags**
