

Homicide suspect gives up to police

City officials announced Tuesday that the suspect wanted in a March 8 killing surrendered to police last week.

The 17-year-old was accompanied by his grandmother, mother, guardian and sister, said city spokesman Frank Baraff. He said Orange detectives had canvassed the neighborhood after the shooting of Jamal Robinson and were able to identify the suspect and obtain a warrant.

Baraff said the boy's family facilitated his surrender. He was processed into custody by the police and sent to the Essex County Youth House.
