

Preschool signups begin

Registration is under way for parents of city children who may be eligible for the Orange School District's preschool program.

Students who will be 3 and 4 years old by Oct. 1 are eligible for free preschool through the district.

Registration sessions are planned weekdays from 9 a.m. to noon in the district registrar's office in Orange High School, 400 Lincoln Ave.

Parents or guardians of age-eligible children must provide proof of eligibility. Required documents include:

- Original birth certificate.
- Child's immunization record.

- Current lease or mortgage statement.

- Proofs of residency, such as utility bills.

For families who live without rent or with a friend or relative, the host's lease or mortgage statement must be presented as well as an affidavit attesting to eligible residency.

Special education and services may be available for preschool students in need. Contact the registrar for information about requesting an evaluation.
