

Orange seeks skills of senior volunteers

Officials in Orange want to connect local programs and services with the knowledge that could be provided by senior residents through a new initiative.

The Retired and Senior Volunteer Program can guide residents older than 55 to service

opportunities that match their skills and ability. Among the skills that can be tapped are immunizing children, providing food for the homeless, and helping with relief services.

The program is a national effort produced by the Senior Corps of the Corporation for

National and Community Service.

Time flexibility is available and residents can volunteer for as much as they are comfortable. They will receive orientation, on-the-job training and supplemental insurance while on duty.
