

Quotes Needed for Emergency Computer Services

The City of Orange Township is accepting quotes for emergency services to clean up and restore 275 nodes (work station) that were infected with malware that is spreading through email. This is a full blown infection that is crippling work stations.

Quotes should be provided on an hourly basis and on a flat fee basis with an estimate of the amount of time it will take to fix this problem.

All work stations and servers must be scrubbed and all unauthorized software must be removed in the process of scrubbing.

This work, which is considered to be an emergency, must be performed between the hours of 4 pm and 8 am, beginning Wednesday May 17. The quote should include the number of people to be assigned to the job.

The 275 work stations are located in 5 separate locations: 2 firehouses, Orange Police Department, Orange City Hall and at the DPW facility at Brook Alley.
